

## Removal of stock system:

- 1. Loosen the nut on the band clamp located behind the catalytic converter using a 15mm wrench or socket.
- 2. Remove the muffler and tail pipe from the OEM rubber hangers. On 03-04 trucks remove bottom shock bolt of the passenger side shock to remove the system in one piece. **This is not required on 05 and newer models**. Separate the stock exhaust at the slip joint located behind the catalytic converter and remove the muffler and tail pipe from under the truck. **Reinstall the bottom shock bolt.**
- 3. Using a 15mm wrench or socket, **loosen** the two nuts holding the catalytic converter inlet flange together.
- 4. Remove the spare tire. You may not be able to reinstall your spare tire after the installation of this exhaust system.

## **Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:**

- 1. Install the **3.5" to 5" Extension Pipe** over the OEM pipe behind the **Catalytic Converter**. The **Extension Pipe** is pre-cut to fit a Crew Cab Long Bed truck. For Super Cab Long Bed trucks the **Extension Pipe** needs to be cut to a length of 29". For Crew Cab Short Bed trucks the **Extension Pipe** needs to be cut to a length of 27.5". For Super Cab Short Bed trucks the **Extension Pipe** needs to be cut to a length of 13". For the Regular Cab Long Bed the **Extension Pipe** needs to be cut to a length of 8".
- 2. Install the **5"Band Hanger Clamp** into the OEM rubber hanger located on the frame beside the inlet of the **Muffler Delete**.
- 3. Install the **Muffler Delete** over the **Extension Pipe**.
- 4. Install the **5" Band Dual Hanger Clamp** into the two OEM rubber hangers located above the outlet of the **Muffler Delete**.
- 5. Install the **Over Axle Pipe** from the rear of the truck, over the axle and attach to the outlet of the **Muffler Delete**.
- 6. Install the **Tail Pipe** onto the **Over Axle Pipe** using the **5"Band Clamp**. Insert the hanger into the OEM hanger to complete.
- 7. The shortest 5" Hanger Clamp is only required for installations on crew cab trucks. Adjust the Tail Pipe and check along the whole length of the exhaust system.
- 8. Ensure there is adequate clearance around everything including the fuel, brake lines and any wiring. If there is any interference detected, relocate or adjust. Tighten all connections.
- 8. If a tip has been purchased, install and adjust to suit. Tighten the lock bolt located on the **Tip**. **A Tip is not included with this kit**. Tips may be purchased separately, check with your dealer.
